

Dear Members of SF Marina Harbor Association:

To update you on events since the Meeting, I spoke with Mary Hobson of SF Rec and Park last week. She said that W&K Engineers' surveyor is on-site, with the following plan:

June 2009:

Existing Facility Condition Survey and Assessment
Hydrographic Survey
Topographic Survey
Sediment Sampling

July 2009:

Geotechnical Investigation
Sedimentation Analysis
Wave Protection Analysis
Circulation and Water Quality Analysis
Initiation of Marina Layout Alternative Analysis

Jericho is supposed to dredge the West Harbor entrance in June, but its equipment is not yet on-site. As a back-up, the Department will request bids for a new contract for dredging in July in case Jericho does not complete the job.

I asked what is the earliest anyone could see areas inside West Harbor dredged, and she responded that the earliest dredging window would be June-Nov 2010, and that the staging plan would be suggested by W&K but finalized by the contractor based on both efficiency and least disruption to harbor operations.

Mary will make an informational presentation to SF Rec and Park Commission on East Harbor sediment remediation on June 18 at 4 PM in City Hall Room 416. She will present the volume and character of contamination and review of alternative remediation plans, same info as presented to us at April 14 Harbor Association meeting, but in greater detail, with the goal to obtaining the Commission's direction as to which alternative to pursue in negotiations with PGE.
