The Environmental Impact Report has been approved and passed by the Board of Supervisors, and loan documents are now being reviewed by the State of California. We will hold the next general membership meeting on August 2 instead of the previously discussed June 14 as there is little happening until those documents are approved. We will then move to the design and engineering stage at which your input is desired.

On May 10, a subcommittee of the Board of Supervisors heard a presentation from advocates of dry boat storage and then directed the SF Rec and Park Department to perform a Feasibility Study on a possible expansion of dry boat storage as a separate project outside the harbor renovation program. RPD will report back in 8 months, at which time the Board might schedule a follow-up hearing.

Your Officers and Board of Directors have worked diligently to assure that the harbor rebuilding project moves forward. We now request you renew your membership – only \$20 per year or \$50 for three years – going up to \$25 per year or \$60 for three years, as of Aug 2, so take advantage of the low three year rate now!
